KENYON COX, born in Warren, Ohio, 1856. Studied in Cincinnati, in Philadelphia, and in Paris under Carolus Duran and Gérôme.

Member of the National Academy of Design; National Institute and American Academy of Arts and Letters; Architectural League of New York; Mural Painters. Awarded Second Hallgarten Prize, National Academy of Design, 1889; Two Bronze Medals Paris Exposition, 1889; Temple Silver Medal, Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts, 1891; Medal World's Columbian Exposition, Chicago, 1893; Gold Medal St. Louis Exposition, 1904; Medal of Honor for Painting, Architectural League, 1910; Isador Medal, Winter Exhibition, National Academy of Design, 1910-11. Master of Arts, Yale University, 1910.

Works consist of portraits, figure pieces and decorations. Executed mural decorations in the Library of Congress; Walker Art Gallery, Bowdoin College; Minnesota State Capitol; Iowa State Capitol; Luzerne County Court House, Wilkes-Barré, Pa.; Appellate Court, New York; Public Library, Winona, Minn., and many other important public buildings.

Mr. Cox is also an author, a teacher and a lecturer upon art.
