

MUSEUM STUDIES FINDING AID (updated 02/2010)

This guide to the Art Institute's *Museum Studies* was created for quick access to the principle topics covered by the articles, vol. 1 (1966) to present vol. 35, no. 2 (2009). It does not index all of the subjects discussed within the studies, nor does it index all significant subject terms, nor all of the illustrations; titles of works appear italicized in parentheses.
