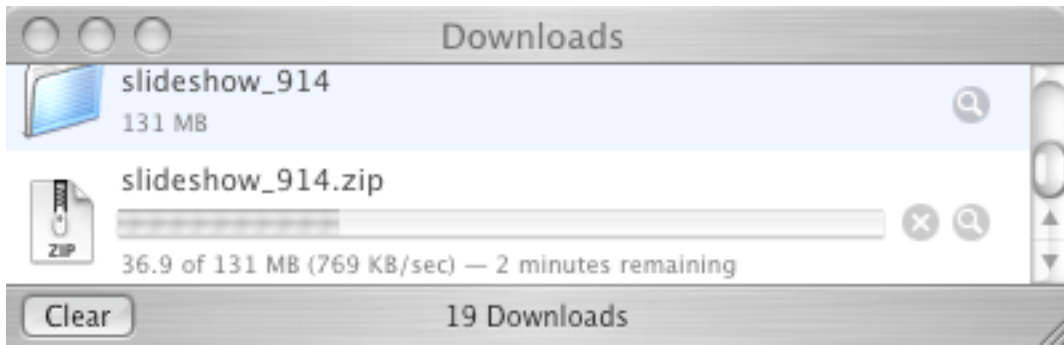

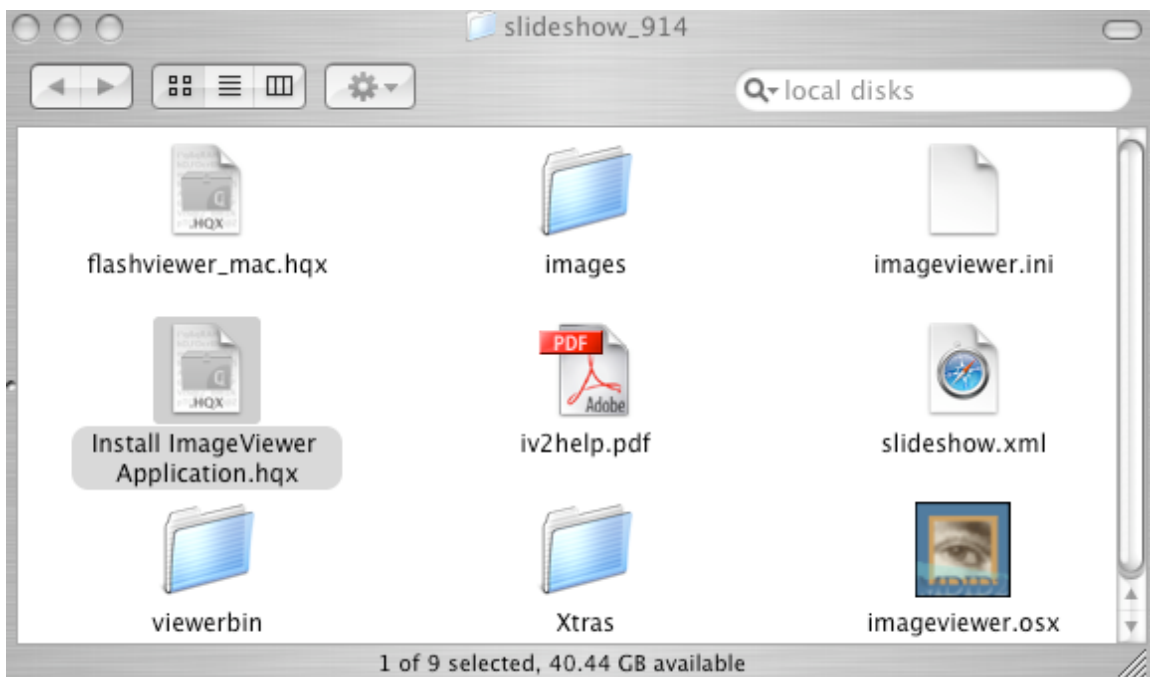

\* Open the folder you just created by unzipping the downloaded package, and run "ImageViewer.exe" on Windows or "ImageViewer.osx" on Mac OS X. On a Mac, you will have to unstuff the "Install ImageViewer Application.hqx" first.



\* You are now using the ImageViewer. Click the "Launch Package" button to view your Slideshow. (See the MDID2 ImageViewer2 Guide or click the "HELP" link or "?" button to view instructions for using the ImageViewer.)
